

# CORPORATE PARTNERSHIPS

Harvest of Hope Pantry is a Boulder 501(c)(3) that provides healthy, free food to Boulder families and individuals in need in a safe, welcoming, and non-judgmental environment.

Our pantry opened its doors in 2012 and now serves 1,200 clients each week on average, distributing 525,000+ pounds of food in 2016.

## We serve two different populations:

- » People with kitchens — families and individuals without the means to pay for all of their food needs.
- » People without kitchens — mostly individuals who are currently homeless.

Our pantry provides healthy, supplemental food to Boulder residents experiencing food insecurity. We offer a grocery-like shopping experience where individuals select their preferred foods. Harvest of Hope enables many of our clients to pay bills AND eat. We are non-sectarian, and welcome all who come through our door.

The Pantry was formed when two Boulder Catholic parishes — St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Center and Sacred Heart of Jesus — joined forces to serve their clients under one roof. These two parishes had been feeding the Boulder area hungry for over 40 years combined before establishing Harvest of Hope Pantry.
