

CORPORATE PARTNERSHIPS

Harvest of Hope Pantry is the only Pantry in Boulder providing healthy, free food to anyone who walks through our doors.

The Pantry opened its doors in 2012. After decades of running separate food assistance programs and continuing to see an increase in the number of people in need of food aid, two local Catholic parishes (St. Thomas Aquinas and Sacred Heart of Jesus) joined forces in the form of a 501(c)(3) Pantry, to formalize operations and connect individuals to other services. Based on feedback from partners like Community Food Share, Boulder Shelter for the Homeless and Emergency Family Assistance Association (EFAA), it was determined that none of the existing organizations had the capacity to serve everyone experiencing food insecurity in Boulder. Since then, we have continued to grow steadily in terms of client numbers and capacity and are now the only food pantry in Boulder serving everyone who comes through our door.

The Pantry offers two types of programs, in order to feed anyone experiencing food insecurity

- » A weekly program for people with kitchens – families and individuals without means to pay for all of their food needs.
- » A daily program for people without kitchens – mostly people experiencing homelessness.

The Pantry provides healthy, supplemental food to Boulder residents experiencing food insecurity. We offer a grocery-like shopping experience where individuals select their preferred foods. Harvest of Hope helps relieve the burden and stress of food insecurity by allowing clients the opportunity to redirect scarce funds toward paying their bills, rather than having to spend money on food. The Pantry also works hard to minimize food waste among Boulder grocery stores and food businesses by partnering with organizations like Boulder Food Rescue, Justin's Nut Butter and GreenSpoon to name a few. We are non-sectarian, and welcome all who come through our door.
